


Brigade Foundation

A household name wherever Kannada is read and spoken, Kupalli Venkatappa Puttappa (K.V. Puttappa, 1904-1994) is revered as one of the great Kannada

poets of the 20th century. He has written over 70 books, including poetry, novels, essays and plays.

Kuvempu believed in "manuja mata, vishva patha" (mankind's religion is the universal path of all people), a philosophy reflected in several of his poems and essays.

Our logo is the visual translation of our motto.

The bird, a seagull, represents the soaring spirit and intellectual freedom.

The yellow square stands for energy, optimism and happiness.

Pre-school, being a child's first experience in the formal education system, can be an anxious time for both children and parents. Which is why we have taken special care to create a warm, welcoming and cheerful atmosphere, in which children feel secure and happy. An environment that makes them want to come to school each morning.

Learning is encouraged and facilitated through enlightened, child-friendly teachers; individual attention to children; group discussions and interactions and carefully selected books and learning aids. The emphasis is on anxiety-free learning rather than reading and writing by rote. Nature, singing and painting are a much-loved part of everyday school life. Children learn other important lessons too: to share, abide by simple rules, get on well with other children and accept the authority of kindly adults.

And with the confidence that our Pre-school children gain in this nurturing environment, their transition to primary school becomes a smooth and happy progression.

Our Facilities

The Brigade School is located within the campus of a beautiful, 22-acre residential enclave in J.P. Nagar, South Bangalore.

Some of the enclave facilities—such as a swimming pool, and a landscaped three-acre park, with floodlit amphitheatre, ministadium and basketball court; —are available to the school. Other highlights include:

- The tree-dotted quadrangle, with a stage at one end, which is the school's main gathering place for daily morning assemblies, small school ceremonies and tea and lunch breaks.
- Spacious, well-ventilated classrooms that open out into wide, bright hallways.
- The "wall encyclopaedias" that run the length of nearly all hallways, which are as informative as they are beautiful.

- Landscaped gardens at both ground and terrace levels.
- Airy, well-equipped laboratories for physics, chemistry, biology and life skills.
- Separate language and math laboratories.
- A spacious and cheery library and well equipped audio-visual room.
- A large computer centre, with floor-to-ceiling windows running along one side, equipped with 40 computers.
- A Tuck Shop, where healthy snacks are available during tea and lunch breaks.

The school will also have access to the air-conditioned, 450-seat auditorium at the MLR Convention Centre, located just across the road. The auditorium will have a large stage with professional sound and lighting facilities.

Our academic focus is based on a philosophy of teaching that is consistent with exemplary practices and meets national standards in education.

We follow the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) syllabus, widely regarded as one with the most enlightened outlook and curricula within our education system. The core faculty of the school is a proactive team of experienced teachers, who combine high standards of teaching with sensitivity to the emotional needs of their students.

Each stage of schooling—primary, middle and high—is carefully constructed. A student's journey from one level of school to the next is made as seamless and rewarding as possible.

Our Curriculum

Our academic curriculum from Std 1 to Std 10:

- English (medium of instruction)
- Second Language options:
- Standards 1-5: Kannada or Hindi
- Standards 6-10: Kannada, Hindi or Sanskrit
- Third Language options:
 Standards 6-8: Kannada, Hindi or Sanskrit
 (Hindi is mandatory, as either a second or third language option)
- Mathematics
- Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Science)
- History, Civics and Geography (Social Science)

two sections (36 children per section), with two trained teachers each for Nursery and LKG, along with ayahs.

Primary School : Standards 1 to 3

Middle School : Standards 4 to 8

High School : Standards 9 & 10

Standards 1 to 10 have three sections of 36 children each.



We believe that what goes on outside the classroom is as important as what goes on within it. Our regular academic timetable is therefore complemented by a variety of co-curricular courses, clubs and activities.

The entire school—from Standards 1 to 10—benefits from our co-curricular courses. Even though they have a full schedule, students of Standards 6 to 10 enjoy participating in at least one Sport and one Art/Performing Arts/Club activity.

Art and Performing Arts
